Nomad, height 15 ½" width 9", is a wall hanging clock, shown on page 151 as #412 in Tran Duy Ly's Ingraham clock book. Note the label on the back. Ingraham "Exotic"



Ingraham Model SST4

Model SST4 electric tambour c.1934 is 16 ¼" long and 6 ¾" high. It has a gold plated sash surrounding a 4 ½" etched silver plated dial. The case is mahogany veneer inlaid with Indian rosewood veneer on the front. There is carved molding around the case and mahogany feet. Ingraham Model SA1

Model SA1 electric clock is 6 ¼" high and 5 ½" wide. The mahogany and walnut case has silk-lined radio tone-grills in the sides. It has a two-tone silver plated dial and a gold plated sash with gold plated shut off on the top. This information is from the Ingram book by Tran Duy Ly on page 129. The clock is #322. Ingraham Model D212

Ingraham Model SA1

Model SA1 is 6 ¼" high and 5 ½" wide. The mahogany and walnut case is very worn. The silver and gold dial looks fine, as does the gold plated sash and shut off knob. Ingraham Model SA219

Model SA219 is an electric alarm clock c.1934. It is 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " high by 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide.
